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## November 25 – Day Before Thanksgiving Schedule

Teachers will have virtual classes – they will be zooming with their whole class (both A.M. and P.M. sessions) together in the morning. ## WEEKLY HEALTH ATTESTATION

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We are changing from a daily health attestation to a **weekly** health attestation. At the beginning of each week, parents must attest to the health of their children and agree to check for COVID-19 symptoms daily. Until we have evidence that parents have done ongoing health screening, and filled out this form on the first day of each week, students will not be allowed in their classroom. This includes students who may be absent on a Monday. If we do not have this evidence, we will wait with students in our commons until a parent can be reached, and the parent can answer questions about the health of their children. Then, children can go to their classes. We ask that this form is completed by 7:30 a.m. for our morning students, and 11:30 a.m. for our afternoon students.

You will be getting an e-mail and a text **each Monday morning** from White Bluffs Elementary to remind you to fill out this attestation form. Even if your child is not attending school on a Monday, this form is to be filled out each Monday. Here is the link:

We also found a way to create a short cut on our phones to call up this google form:



When you have the form open, hit  and scroll up to “add to Home Screen”. Hit that. The Google Form is now on your home screen and can be used every day. The weekly attestation will ask several questions to assess how a child is feeling and whether they are reporting any COVID-19-like symptoms or exposure to the novel coronavirus. **It is important that families complete the questionnaire each week even if they know they will keep their child home due to illness or COVID-19 exposure so schools can track illness and absences for COVID-19.**



Here is a QR Code you also can use to quickly get to the attestation form. This QR Code has been sent home with all students, and we have posted this on ClassTag for easy accessibility. Just bring up your camera on your iPhone or Android and choose the document. It is easy!
